## Support for horse riders to be recognised as Vulnerable Road Users

I am writing to behalf of the Joint Nelson Tasman Regional Transport Committee to give our full support for horse riders to be formally recognised as Vulnerable Road Users in New Zealand transport legislation.

Recognition will ensure the consideration of equestrians in decision making and allow for formal safety messaging and initiatives to help keep them safe on New Zealand's roads.

Nelson / Tasman is a large area home to a significant equestrian community, particularly in our smaller settlements and vast rural areas.
